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- Chairman Berube noted that there have been 2 accident-related fatalities in 2020; one on Haverhill Road and one at Candia Road & Chester Street.

78 **3.2** Reports from Departments

80 Mr. Methot:

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 He asked if the scarecrows created hazardous conditions due to distracting drivers during the month of October; Chairman Berube said unfortunately yes. Chairman Berube explained that all possible measures are taken to reduce the hazards associated. Officers did address stopping and standing in the road on numerous occasions.

Fire Captain Gladu:

• For safety's sake, smaller apparatus is used in the winter months when possible, with the larger vehicles being kept in the garage.

Town Planner Hadik:

- He contacts Mike Dugas at NHDOT every three months to check the status of the route 102/121 intersection; there has been no movement on a solution. NHDOT is experiencing staffing shortages. Mr. Hadik believes that a solution won't be reached until after the COVID-19 pandemic is over.
- Jenkins Farm Road and Wilcombs Way were supposed to be paved before winter, but this did not happen.
 - The PB renewed the Conditions of Approval for Crowley Woods (but it's still a long way from being approved by Candia).
 - The PB will renew the 1-lot subdivision on Pulpit Rock Road.
 - A 36-acre parcel on Haverhill Road has been purchased by a developer who will likely

- apply for a subdivision.
- A 157-acre parcel at the end of Pulpit Rock Road has been purchased by a developer who will likely apply for subdivision; this could have significant impact on roads and a traffic study will be required.

Town Administrator Doda:

• She will keep an eye on the storm due to come in tonight into tomorrow; please work from home if you can. She is not sure if the BOS will opt to close the building entirely.

Road Agent Oleson:

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
- Please keep cars close together and park along the edge of the Town Hall parking lot to enable the crews to plow. However, he would advise the BOS to close the building.
- The North Pond Road reconstruction has been very successful. The new culverts are effective and there is no more flooding across the road. Only guardrails and wear course need to be done in spring. Per DES, there will also be 400-500 plants comprising 3 different species that will be planted on the slopes in the spring, which need to be monitored for 5 years at a cost of ~\$1,000-1,500/year.
 - The new hotbox has become a very helpful tool in road repairs.
- 2-3 large trees were removed in the last storm; they were old, dead trees that were ready to fall.

Maintenance Supervisor Cavanaugh:

- All is well. He is also overseeing the Transfer Station. A new sanitation fogger was purchased which works very well and he expects to be able to use it a couple times per week.
- 128 **Building AA Wilson:** Nothing to report.
- 130 Police Chief Berube:
 - Accidents were down during the last storm because it occurred on a Saturday.
- There have been some members of the PD in guarantine.
 - Tomorrow's storm will likely result in an increase of accidents.
- Another cruiser is out for repair because someone backed into it in the center of town.
