Other comments:

### Town

- What level of service should the Town be providing?
- If a Department is doing its work satisfactorily, they should consider not purchasing any new equipment. It is not necessary to raise & appropriate, and then spend, ~\$800k every year.
- It would be nice if maintenance of the Eagle Scout projects was included with the project.

### **Highway Department**

- A new Highway Office/Garage would be best situated on the property where the Salt Shed is now. Quonset hut or pole barn style was suggested.
- Could the Highway Department buy a used vehicle in FY19-20 rather than new?

# **Police Department**

- Are there companies that create standard Police Station plans, somewhat like franchise buildings?
- Do the residents want a new Police Station, or do they want the roads repaired?
- Can the Police Department purchase a cruiser every other year rather than every year? The Police Department will be at the November 7<sup>th</sup> Planning Board meeting; this would be a good time to discuss it. They should also consider electric vehicles.
- The Police Department roof can be done in-house.

# **Transfer Station**

• If the Transfer Station does not use the Skid Steer, why not get rid of it? They can use the Town's backhoe instead.

After the Planning Board meets with the Department Heads and the Selectmen, the Selectmen should review the 'all new CIP' at one of their meetings.
