### 1.1 Call to Order

# II. New Business

## 2.1 Spraying for Ticks

Recreation Director Reishus has received many complaint calls from parents about ticks on their children after being on the Town and Wason Pond Fields. She has procured quotes from TruGreen and Mosquito Joe, both in the \$2,500 range. She does not have the funds in her budget. Groundskeeper John Dalrymple was consulted; he does not have the proper license to do the work himself, and believes those prices are reasonable.

Mr. Myette stated that there is nothing in the Wason Pond Conservation Easement document that would preclude spraying.

Recreation Director Reishus is concerned about the summer program; Selectman D'Angelo is concerned about liability. There was some discussion about where the funding would come from.

Selectman D'Angelo moved to authorize spraying for ticks at the Town and Wason Pond fields using funds from the Recreation Revolving Account; Chairman Trask seconded the motion. The vote was three in favor with Selectman Buckley opposed and Selectman Owens absent; motion carried.

# III. Adjournment

The next regularly scheduled meeting of the Board of Selectmen will be Thursday, May 17<sup>th</sup>, 2018.

### Chairman Trask moved to adjourn the meeting; Vice-Chairman Cannon seconded the motion. The vote was four in favor with Selectman Owens absent; motion carried.
