Plastic #1 - #7	ALL #1 - #7 PLASTICS Examples: Soda Bottles, Milk, Water, Juice, Bleach, Softener, Laundry, Dish Soap, Yogurt Containers	No caps Rinse	No automotive product bottles
ALUMINUM	ALL soda/beer cans	Rinse Crush	NO aluminum foil, pie plates, or foil pans
TIN CANS	Dog & cat food, vegetables, tuna, soup, sauces, metal jar lids and can tops	Rinse Remove both ends Crush Labels OK	
AEROSOL CANS	Air Freshener, Hair Spray, Lysol	Labels OK Do not crush	
GLASS	ALL clear, green, and brown glass jars and bottles	Remove caps/lids Rinse Labels OK	No light bulbs, mirrors, dishes, ceramics, or windowpanes
NEWSPAPER	Newspapers and inserts	Loose Stack neatly in Trailer	
MAGAZINES		Place in marked box in Trailer	
MIXED PAPER and non-corrugated cardboard	All other paper – junk mail, cereal boxes, egg cartons, beer/soda cartons, bags <u>with</u> plastic liners, colored paper	Place in marked Trailer	
CARDBOARD	Corrugated cardboard ONLY (has air space between layers); pizza boxes OK unless very greasy	Break down and stack neatly in Trailer	
BATTERIES	Automobile and household	Recycled – check with Attendant	
BROWN BAGS AND FEED BAGS	Dog food, birdseed bags, horse feed bags <u>without</u> plastic liners	Flatten and place in Cardboard Trailer	
MOTOR OIL & TRANSMISSION FLUID	Motor oil and transmission fluid only (nothing mixed in)	Pour into container at Transfer Station	NO antifreeze or brake fluid
TIRES	Remove tire rims	See Attendant, pay fee for disposal	NO tires on rims
FREON-CONTAINING APPLIANCES	Refrigerators, freezers, air conditioners, dehumidifiers, etc.	See Attendant, pay fee for disposal	

MATERIAL	ACCEPTED	HOW	NOT ACCEPTED
TVS & COMPUTER EQUIPMENT	Monitors, keyboards, CPUs & Televisions	See Attendant, pay fee for disposal of TVs and Monitors	
FURNITURE	Take to Raymond	Route 107, Prescott Road	
RUGS & CARPETING	Four-foot squares accepted	Cut into four-foot squares Roll up Put in Compactor	
YARD WASTE	Leaves, pine needles, grass clippings, potted plants	Dump in Compost Pile Remove pots from plants	NO brush in compost pile – brush in burn pile
CAT/DOG LITTER		Bag and place in Solid Waste Compactor	
SCRAP METAL/APPLIANCES	Old motors, lawn mowers, microwave ovens, car parts, washer/dryers, baling wire	Motors must be drained of oil and gasoline	NO gas cylinders
SCRAP WOOD	Clean (unpainted) lumber and brush	5" diameter, 10' maximum length Put in Burn Pile	NO varnished wood NO plywood/particle board NO pressure treated NO painted wood
LATEX PAINTS	Dried up latex paint only	Open can Allow to dry Dispose of clean can in metal pile	NO oil base paints/stains Cans containing dried paint go in trash.
CONCRETE BLOCKS		See Attendant Put in Concrete Pile	
CERAMICS AND OTHER GLASS	Toilets, sinks, tiles, mirrors, dishes, ceramics, windowpanes	See Attendant	NO light bulbs
FLUORESCENT TUBES		Give to Compactor Attendant

CLOTHING (CLEAN)	NOT ACCEPTED	Take to Chester Clothes Closet at 84 Chester Street Annex Building. Wednesday 7-9pm; Saturday 1-3pm.	
CONSTRUCTION DEMOLITION DEBRIS	NOT ACCEPTED	Take to Raymond. Route 107, Prescott Road	
PROPANE TANKS / FIRE EXTINGUISHERS	ACCEPTED	See Attendant – pay fee for disposal	
CHEMICALS, CLEANING SOLVENTS, & OIL BASE PAINTS	NOT ACCEPTED	Hold for the biannual Household Hazardous Waste Day. Fall & Spring as announced.	
USED BOOKS – BINDINGS INTACT	ACCEPTED	Put in Book Swap Building	
ENCYCLOPEDIAS	ACCEPTED	Put in Mixed Paper Trailer
