Dear Neighbor,

As part of our everyday effort to deliver reliable energy to our customers and communities, we are preparing to inspect transmission structures in Derry, Chester, Sandown, Danville, Kingston, East Kingston, and Kensington. This routine maintenance work is designed to maintain the reliability of the electric system serving New Hampshire.

We're Always Working to Serve You Better

This month, Eversource's contractor Osmose will be inspecting steel transmission structures. This work will take place within the power line corridor from Highland Road, Kensington to Brewster Road, Derry.

What You Can Expect

Since your property is on or near the power line corridor, here is important information about how we will work in your neighborhood:

- **Reliable Service:** Be assured that this work will not interrupt electric service to your property.
- **Proper Identification:** All people working on this project carry identification.
- **Where We'll Be Working:**
 - Derry: Brewster Road, Scobie Pond Road, Route 28 Bypass, Paul Avenue, English Range Road, Chester Road, Faith Drive, Old Auburn Road, Pomp Road
 - Chester: Pomp Road, Haverhill Road
 - Sandown: Wells Village Road, Pheasant Run Drive, Main Street, Sargent Road, Cross Road, Fremont Road
 - Danville: Tucker Town Road, GH Carter Drive, Main Street, Meadow Lark Lane, Pine Street, Kingston Road, Route 111
 - Kingston: Route 111, Towle Road, Mill Road, Stoneybrook Lane, Route 125, Folly Brook Terrace, Small Pox Road, New Boston Road
 - East Kingston: Haverhill Road, Bowley Road, Sullivan Drive, Burnt Swamp Road, South Road
 - Kensington: Highland Road, Old Amesbury Road, Amesbury Road
- **Communication:** Keeping the lines of communication open is important to us. Before work starts, our field outreach representatives will be in touch, either in person or with a door hanger notice to provide more details about the inspection schedule for your area. We will also provide updates to keep you informed of our work. - **Work Days:** Work will take place Monday through Friday, and Saturdays as necessary. Please keep in mind that the schedule may change due to weather and other unexpected circumstances.
- **Work Activities:**
 - > **IN THE COMING WEEKS:** Small crews will be traveling on ATV's within the power line corridor, inspecting and treating the steel structures, foundations, and guy anchors. This may require hand excavating around the guy anchors, and if so the area will be restored.
 - > **OVERALL,** you can expect:
 - There will be ATV's on the power line corridor, though we will make every effort to minimize any impact to your property.

- In wetland areas, we may install timber mats, which are flat surfaces to protect an area from construction activities and equipment; they will be removed at the end of the inspections.
 - Restoration, if needed, will take place when the inspection is complete.
- > **PROJECT COMPLETION:** We expect to complete this routine maintenance and do final restoration of disturbed areas, if needed, by the fall of 2018.
