II. Old Business

2.1 Approval of Minutes – June 5, 2023

The draft minutes of June 5, 2023 were distributed to members prior to the meeting.

Recreation Director Reishus moved to accept the Technical Review Committee minutes of June 5, 2023 as written; Town Administrator Doda seconded the motion. The vote was five in favor, with three abstaining (Mr. Bunker, Fire Chief Gladu and Mr. Hadik) and five members absent; motion carried.

III. New Business

3.1 Like Nu – Car Show & Food Trucks at Wason Pond – Sun., Aug. 13, 2023

Joe DeRosa and Alan Foskitt appeared before the TRC to discuss Like Nu's application to hold a car show and food trucks at Wason Pond on Sun., Aug. 13, 2023.

Mr. DeRosa explained that he would like to hold a car show for up to 20 cars which would be open to the public with a couple of food trucks. Would like to park the cars by the small field parking area along Route 102 with main parking by the playground.

Fire Chief Gladu confirmed parking area along the fence lines and making sure the gated area to the field remains open for emergency access to field. Recreation Director suggested putting the food trucks in the island rather than at the playground parking area to save room for vehicles. Recreation Director inquired about permission to have the food trucks on site and Town Administrator Doda will inform the Board of Selectmen of same. Recreation Director also suggested adding a portable or an extra cleaning for portables. Chris Hadik, Chair of Wason Pond Conservation and Recreation Commission suggested having the extra portable up by the car show area. Mr. DeRosa will contact the portable company and communicate with Recreation Director Reishus on placement. Maintenance Director Cavanaugh offered to drop a half dozen town cones for usage to block the top portion from public parking prior to setup.

TRC recommends the applicant consult with Recreation / Facilities department for this event.
