  - Selectman D'Angelo noted that an ordinance is being created for 5G utilities; 5G contractors will likely be required to undergo technical review prior to seeing the Planning Board.
    - Selectman D'Angelo noted that a police traffic detail ordinance is being created as well.
- Selectman D'Angelo suggested recording TRC meetings moving forward; and to let the PACT Committee know for labeling purposes.
